Dear Parents and Guardians

As part of our history topic on crime and punishment, we are pleased to advise that Years 5 and 6 will be visiting Lancaster Castle and the Lancashire Policing Museum on Friday 7th November.

This is an exciting opportunity for the children to learn about how crime, policing and punishments have evolved through different time periods, and trips such as these are always highlights of the children's journeys through school.

Thanks to the generosity of the PTFA, who have donated an amount for each class to utilise on trips this year, we are delighted to be offering this trip **free of charge** to parents. We do however require you to sign up for the trip on School Hub, which has a consent form for you to agree to. We would be grateful if all permissions can be completed before the half term break on Friday 24th October.

The visit will take place in school time but due to the tour timings and distance we will be back slightly later for this one day only. **Please arrange to collect your child from school at 3.45pm on this day.** Any delays due to traffic etc will be communicated via Class Dojo. Those children who have permissions granted to walk home independently will be released, whilst anyone requiring After School Club can book their place via School Hub in the normal fashion.

Children should arrive at school for registration as normal in the morning, please ensure everyone is on time as the coach needs to depart promptly at 09:15. Children should wear full school uniform and please ensure they are dressed appropriately for the weather with coats/rain jackets.

Packed lunches will be available to order and purchase via School Hub, or parents should send a healthy packed lunch from home in a named carrier bag. Please send disposable drinks bottles if possible to minimise what they will need to carry around with them during the day. If your child is entitled to Free School Meals then they will be provided with a packed lunch, but it will need to be ordered in the usual way by yourselves via School Hub.

There is a gift shop on site, so if you would like to send your child with a small amount of cash for any purchases this is totally **optional**. Please send a maximum of £5 if you wish to do so, in a sealed and named envelope to be handed to class teachers on the day.
