



The King's Coronation Celebration Friday 5th May



On **Friday 5th May** we are inviting children to come into school in red, white and blue colours to celebrate the coronation of King Charles III. We are asking for a £1 donation which will go towards school funds.

Throughout the day the children will be taking part in a range of activities and will have the opportunity to create their own keepsake as a reminder of the coronation.

The PTFA will be providing each child with a medal to keep as a souvenir of the event.

As part of His Coronation The King has asked that people give back to their community. With this in mind, children will be taking part in a community litter pick over the course of the day.

There will be a design a crown fit for the King competition for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children. We ask that the children make this at home and then bring it in with them on the day to wear and to be judged. For key stage 2 (Years 3, 4, 5 & 6) there will be a design a stamp in honour of the King. Again, we ask that the children bring their design in with them on the day to be judged. You can be as creative as you like, the templates attached can be used if you wish.
