**Cost**

School subsidises swimming sessions however, we ask parents for a contribution towards the coach. We are asking all parents to make a contribution of **£3.00 each week**. Chowbent would like to say a massive thank you in advance for the contributions you will be making. Payments will be made via Lunch Shop.

**Kit**

Children should bring their swimming clothes in a separate, named bag every week.

Girls must wear a swim cap and a one-piece swimming costume.

Boys must wear proper swim trunks and not swim shorts.

Please note that children will not be allowed to swim if they do not have the correct attire.

Children must remove earrings before entering the baths. Please could you do this in the morning before your child comes to school. It is the policy of both the school and the swimming baths that children should not wear earrings and will not accept responsibility for injuries incurred.

Swimming is part of the national curriculum for PE and children are expected to be able to swim 25 metres. Regular attendance is therefore essential (not optional) and children should bring a written note signed by a parent for non-attendance.
