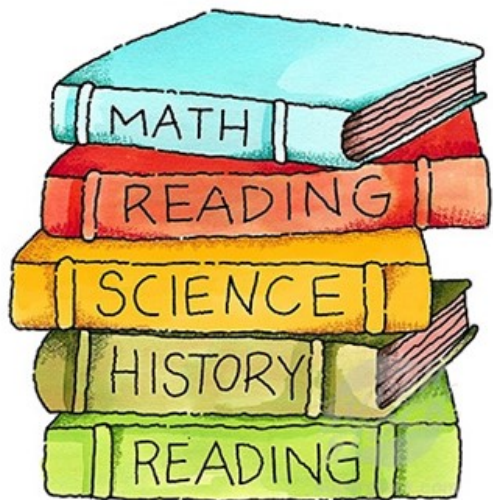


# What will school look like from March 8th?



## Class Bubbles



## Recovery Curriculum

**School will need to continue to control the risk of Covid 19 with the following measures:**

- ◆ Each year group will stay in a separated class bubble.
- ◆ Each class bubble will have its own separate break and lunch times.
- ◆ Each bubble will start and end the school day at different times.
- ◆ The school will limit as much as possible how many staff work with each bubble and across bubbles.
- ◆ In Key Stage 2 there will still not be sets for English and Maths.
- ◆ If a positive case of Covid 19 occurs in a bubble, that bubble will be sent home to self-isolate for 10 days. If this happens CHOWBENT@home will run for those pupils sent home.
- ◆ Lunchtimes will be reduced to 30 minutes to allow for each class bubble to have separate lunch breaks.
- ◆ School will finish earlier than usual because of the reduced lunchtime. The length of the teaching day will remain the same.
- ◆ Hot meals will be available again from the school kitchens, which can be ordered through Lunch Shop.
- ◆ There will be more frequent handwashing and ventilation of classrooms.
- ◆ School staff (who agree) will take two lateral flow covid tests per week before school. This is to help identify asymptomatic covid cases amongst the school staff.

**What we teach will change this year to allow us to tackle the impact of COVID 19 on learning during lockdown.**

- ◆ More teaching time will be given to core subjects and pastoral support.  
Mental arithmetic and problem solving, times tables, phonics and spelling, handwriting, science, writing, reading comprehension, PSHE, P4C, daily work-outs and guided reading.
- ◆ We will assess where the children are more regularly, especially in the first few weeks back.
- ◆ There will be additional booster activities for the children who need extra support.



## Information for parents.

- ◆ Attendance at school will be compulsory from March 8th.
- ◆ There will still be a one-way system around the outside of the school for drop-off and pick-up.
- ◆ Parents will still not be able to linger or form groups and must maintain social distancing.
- ◆ We will continue to use Class Dojo for messaging instead of the classroom planners.
- ◆ There will still be different start times and home times for each different class bubble.
- ◆ A child who displays any symptoms of COVID 19 will have to be collected from school immediately and a test booked. School must be informed of the outcome as soon as it is received.
- ◆ A child who displays any symptoms of Covid 19 at home, or if anyone in their household displays symptoms, then they must not be sent in to school.
- ◆ Children may not bring in items from home to school apart from coats & P.E. kits (kept in class in a PE bag) and home packed lunches if they have them. Pens/pencils etc will be supplied in school.
- ◆ There will be no Chowbent Champ or whole school assemblies, class based assemblies will take place.
- ◆ Parents Evenings will not take place in the usual format.
- ◆ Lunchtime detentions will be replaced by a report card system.
- ◆ Some parents will have received an NHS letter notifying that they are clinically extremely vulnerable (shielding letter) their children should still attend school.
- ◆ Children who have received an NHS letter notifying that they are clinically extremely vulnerable (shielding letter) should not attend school until further notice. School will need sight of their shielding letter in order to authorise the non-attendance. We will support these pupils with home learning activities via Dojo.
- ◆ Parent face mask wearing outside when on the school site is strongly recommended but will not be enforced.
- ◆ Parents can only enter school via an appointment and must wear a face mask inside the building at all times.
- ◆ We will work back to more normal school start and end times as the easing of lockdown allows. We will give parents advance warning before we make any changes to the current school start and end times.
