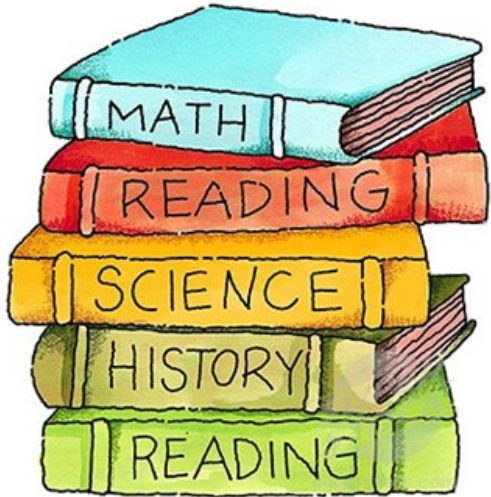


What will school look like in September ?



Class Bubbles



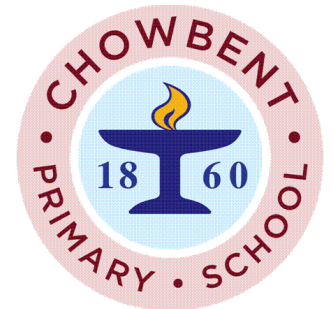
Recovery Curriculum

The main way school will control the risk of Covid 19 is the use of class bubbles.

- ◆ Each year group will stay in a separated class bubble.
- ◆ Each class bubble will have its own separate break and lunch times.
- ◆ Each bubble will start and end the school day at different times.
- ◆ The school will limit as much as possible how many staff work with each bubble and across bubbles.
- ◆ In Key Stage 2 there will not be sets for English and Maths.
- ◆ If a positive case of Covid 19 occurs in a bubble, that bubble will be sent home to self-isolate for 14 days. If this happens CHOWBENT@home will run for those pupils sent home.
- ◆ Lunchtimes will be reduced to 30 minutes to allow for each class bubble to have separate lunch breaks.
- ◆ School will finish earlier than usual because of the reduced lunchtime. The length of the teaching day will remain the same.
- ◆ Hot meals will be available again from the school kitchens, which can be ordered through Lunch Shop.
- ◆ There will be more frequent handwashing.

What we teach will change this year to allow us to tackle the impact of COVID 19 on learning during lockdown.

- ◆ More teaching time will be given to core subjects and pastoral support.
Mental arithmetic and problem solving, times tables, phonics and spelling, handwriting, science, writing, reading comprehension, PSHE, P4C, daily work-outs and guided reading.
- ◆ We will assess where the children are more regularly.
- ◆ There will be additional booster activities for the children who need extra support.
- ◆ We will have a Fun Friday, where the children will work around a thematic topic in a similar way to what we have been setting on CHOWBENT@home.
- ◆ Our pastoral support will continue more intensively for those who need it.

Clubs and activities

Things will change for parents too.

- ◆ Attendance at school will be compulsory.
- ◆ There will be a one-way system around the outside of the school for drop-off and pick-up.
- ◆ Parents will not be able to linger or form groups and must maintain social distancing.
- ◆ We will use Class Dojo for messaging instead of the classroom planners.
- ◆ There will be different start times and home times for each different class bubble.
- ◆ A child who displays any symptoms of COVID 19 will have to be collected from school immediately and a test booked. School must be informed of the outcome as soon as it is received.
- ◆ A child who displays any symptoms of Covid 19 at home, or if anyone in their household displays symptoms, then they must not be sent in to school.
- ◆ Children may not bring in items from home to school apart from coats & P.E. kits (kept in class in a PE bag) and home packed lunches if they have them. Pens/pencils etc will be supplied in school.
- ◆ There will be no Chowbent Champ or whole school assemblies, class based assemblies will take place.
- ◆ Parents Evenings will not take place in the usual format.
- ◆ Due to the Government's guidance it currently looks highly unlikely that Zak's Childcare will be able to operate from the school site for the foreseeable future.

After school clubs and activities.

- ◆ To keep the class bubbles separate from each other we will not be able to offer the usual range of after school clubs and activities as this would mix children from different year groups together.
- ◆ Any club or activity that we set up would be for individual classes only.
- ◆ Residential to Robinwood and Lockerbie - these are not allowed under the new guidance and sadly these trips will have to be cancelled. Payments made will be refunded to parents.
