



## Junior Librarian System

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are currently adding all the books in our library and reading schemes to a computerised system called Junior Librarian. This will make our record keeping and running of the schemes much more efficient. There is an added benefit in that your child will be able to access information about the books in the library at home. This will help them make choices about what they wish to read, check which books are available and add reviews and recommendations about what they have read. .

Your child will be given their own user name and password to logon to Junior Librarian and there is a link to the site through the school's website (select children from the menu).

As you can appreciate adding all the books to the system is quite time consuming and we would ask for your patience over the next few weeks as we won't be able to send reading books home. Be assured that your child will continue to read in school and as always they are encouraged to read a range of books at home.
