School Uniform

- Maroon crew neck sweatshirt or cardigan (school badge optional, but preferred)
- Pale blue polo shirt/ blouse (school badge is optional)
- Grey knee-length skirt, pinafore or tailored shorts
- Grey trousers
- Pale blue gingham, knee-length summer dress (summer term only)
- Grey or black socks
- Grey or maroon tights
- Plain white socks (summer term only)

Footwear

- Black, flat and sensible shoes must be worn.
- Children must wear trainers on PE days.
- Velcro shoes must be worn if your child is unable to tie shoelaces or fasten buckles.



Optional Items

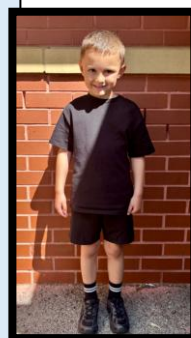
- Chowbent emblem fleece (for use as an outdoor coat only and not to be worn indoors)
- Chowbent emblem book bag (recommended, as it is the ideal size for carrying all essential school items and fits neatly in pupils' lockers.)

Hair

- Hairstyles should be neat, tidy and suitable for school. Long hair should be tied back for school.
- Extreme hairstyles are not permitted. This includes shaved patterns or hair art, Mohican styles and unnatural coloured hair.
- Hair accessories should be small and in school or neutral colours. Your child may be asked to remove any large, oversized bows and accessories that are not in keeping with the school uniform may be asked to be removed.
- We recognise and respect that some hairstyles are worn for cultural, religious or ethnic reasons. We ask that accessories worn with these hairstyles, are in natural colours or school colours.

School PE Uniform - All PE kit should have no logos, branding or slogans and plain black.

- Plain black PE T-shirt
- Plain black zip-up hoodie
- Plain black PE shorts (mid-thigh length)
- Plain black leggings
- Plain black tracksuit bottoms or black jogging pants



Jewellery

Jewellery is not permitted in school, with the exception of an analogue or digital wristwatch, which must be removed for PE and other physical activities.

Smartwatches must be handed into the school office at the start of the day in line with the school's 'Mobile Phone Policy' and collected at the end of the day. Smartwatches are not permitted for children in Reception to Year 4.

Earrings are not permitted. If parents/ carers refuse to follow this guidance, parents/carers will need to accept full responsibility for any injury or damage resulting from their use.

To maintain Health and Safety standards, children are not permitted to wear false nails at school.

Any tattoos/ transfers are also not allowed and staff will ask your child to remove them immediately.
